### **Synopsis of Presentation:**

The scientific sessions will highlight the vital elements of crisis resource management: leadership, decision-making, communication, teamwork, and situational awareness to improve the safety of office-based anesthesia. Lectures will discuss previous anesthetic-related emergency events and analyze in real time what was done well and what could be done belier to improve outcomes.

## **Educational Objectives:**

- 1. Utilize the elements of crisis resource management to improve outcomes in anesthesia
- 2. Discuss and analyze events that occur in office-based anesthetic emergencies
- 3. Highlight the importance of prompt recognition and treatment of respiratory emergencies
- 4. Understand the anesthetic implication of patients using cannabis

#### Dr. Michael K. Rollert - Bio:

Dr. Rollert graduated from Kansas State University in 1992, and the University of Missouri at Kansas City School of Dentistry in 1995. He completed his oral and maxillofacial surgery residency at Virginia Commonwealth University (VCU) in 1999. He is currently a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons and a Fellow of the National Dental Board of Anesthesiology. He has been in private practice in Denver, Colorado since the completion of his residency, and has served as an Associate Professor at the University of Colorado School of Dental Medicine. Dr. Rollert is on the medical staff of Porter Adventist Hospital, Children's Hospital of Colorado & Littleton Adventist Hospital

Dr. Rollert has published multiple articles in the Journal of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery (JOMS), contributed to the textbook *Anesthesia Complications in the Dental Office*, and chaired the most recent update of the American Association of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgeons (AAOMS) Parameters of Care, Anesthesia in Outpatient Facilities, published 2023. He is an invited speaker at conferences throughout the United States and Canada, lecturing on a range of topics to medical anesthesia providers, oral surgeons, dentists, and their staff.

Dr. Rollert has served on the AAOMS Committee on Anesthesia and has chaired the Committee on Continuing Education for the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology (ADSA). He has served in a variety of positions with ADSA, culminating as the President of the American Dental Society of Anesthesiology for the 2017-2019 term. Dr. Rollert is Vice-Chairman of the Dental Patient Safety Foundation (DPSF), a dental patient safety organization. He remains locally involved as a consultant to the Colorado Dental Board, and a member of the state office anesthesia inspection committee.
